EVALUATION OF THE PK's GENDER EQUALITY PLAN (GEP) IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EUROPEAN PROJECT HORIZON 2020 GEECCO

Within the framework of the European project [H2020 GEECCO](#), the interviews for the evaluation of the PK first Gender Equality Plan (2017-2021) by experts [Anke Lipinsky](#) and [Claudia Schredl](#) from the German [Leibniz Institute for Social Sciences](#) (GESIS), the largest European institution dedicated to the social sciences and one of the most prestigious internationally, took place on 12th and 13th June 2019. This was the first evaluation visit in the mid-term of project

Over the two days, the meeting with GEP Core Group at PK and both individual and group interviews were held on various topics and from different perspectives. They will be used to evaluate the current state of GEP building process and many actions carried out under the PK's First Gender Equality Plan and the strategy and leadership of the University regarding gender equality. In addition to the Plan's achievements and its sustainability in the medium and long term, aspects such as the increasing awareness of gender equality within the PK community, resistance and obstacles to gender actions and GEP implementation at PK were discussed.
